

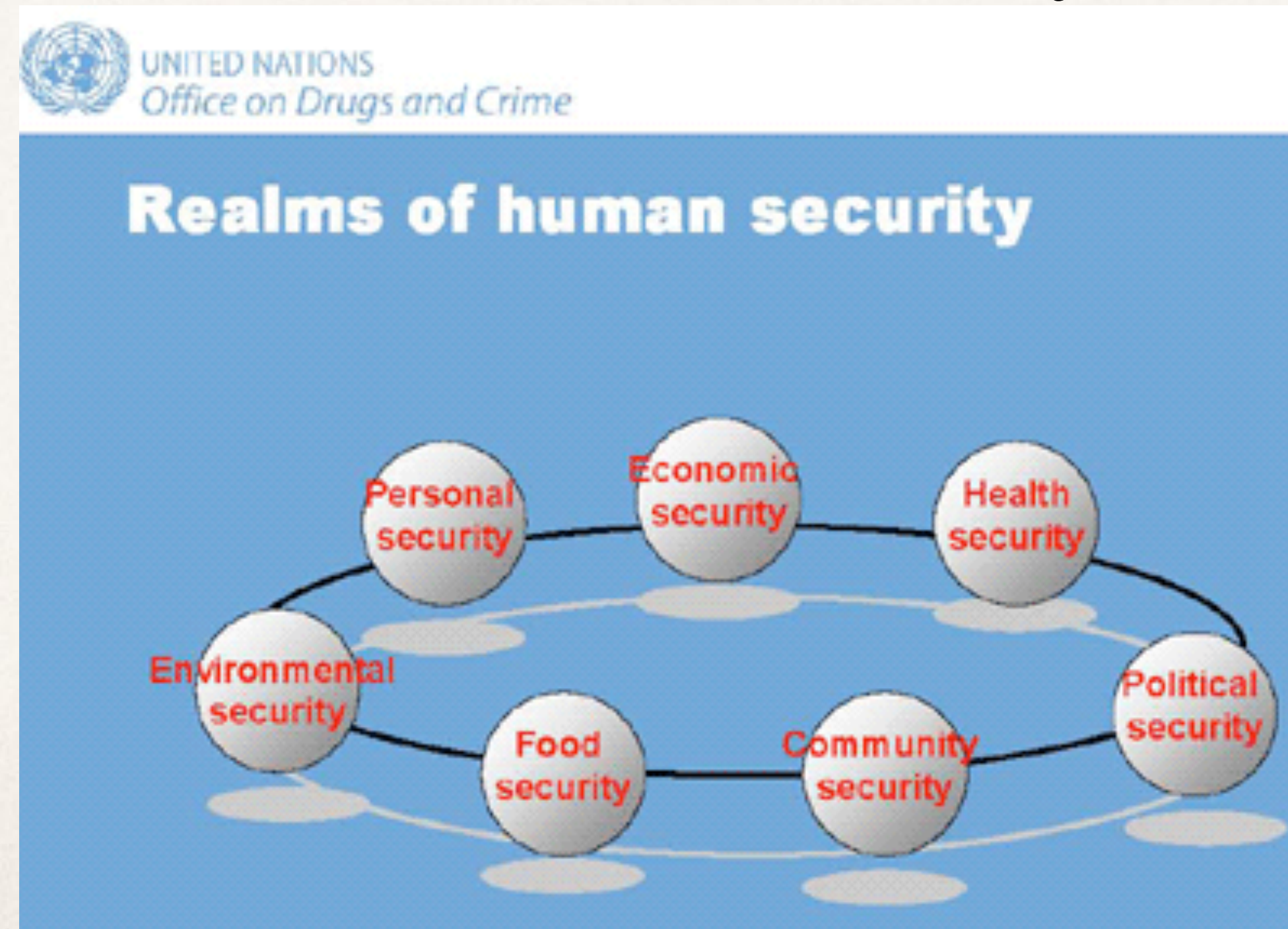

Human Security

- ❖ Effort to redefine security away from the state
- ❖ Draw attention to the ways in the state harms security
- ❖ Individual is the referent



UN HDR 1994

- ❖ Economic security (basic income)
- ❖ Food security (access to basic food)
- ❖ Environmental security (safety from natural and human environmental threats)
- ❖ Personal security (physical safety)
- ❖ Community security (community relations and values)
- ❖ Political security (Basic human rights)

Human Security

- ❖ Solution: Human development
- ❖ Freedom from fear
- ❖ Freedom from want
 - ❖ What role for structural violence?
- ❖ Critics
 - ❖ Concept too broad to be analytically useful
 - ❖ Often unmatched by policy
 - ❖ State is still the primary provider of security
- ❖ Gender plays an important role in human security
